## Checklist for attending UAF Community and Technical College (CTC) as a <u>Bachelor of Science (BS-NS)</u> PRE-NURSING student

Schedule an appointment with an Academic Advisor by calling 455-2800.

Take ACCUPLACER Test for English placement and bring test scores to Advising appt, if haven't taken ACT/SAT OR an English class within the past year. The test can take up to 2 hrs. Take the ALEKS Math Placement test prior to registering for a math class.

Apply for a Certificate in Allied Health: Pre-Nursing Qualifications.

Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), if you need financial aid. Complete non-nursing pre-requisite courses at UAF/CTC, another UA campus, or a college outside Alaska. The courses listed on page 2 are based on UAF course numbers and equivalents. Complete 15 credits of General Education Requirements (GER), required for the BS degree requirement for any UAA bachelor's degree. These can be taken in any order while working on the prerequisites and during the nursing program. However, two courses must be taken from the Humanities UAA GER list, one from the Fine Arts UAA GER list, and two from different disciplines from the Social Science UAA GER list. One of the Social Science GERs can be PSY F101 which is required for PSY F240. The last GER *can* be taken prior to the last trimester.

Maintain a minimum extracted GPA of 3.0 in BS-NS pre req courses and minimum grade of "C"
